



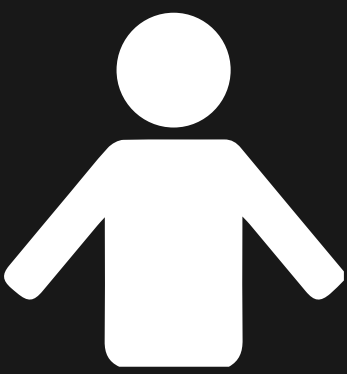

WHAT IS IN WORK POVERTY?

People who earn less than 60% of the median income of a country.



HOW BIG A PROBLEM IS IT IN THE UK?

8% of people were in work poverty in 2013. The rate of child poverty in working families rose from 19% in 2009/10 to 21% in 2013/14.



HOW MANY PEOPLE EARN BELOW THE LIVING WAGE?

In 2013 20% (4.9 million people) earned less than the living wage.
